Duties and Responsibilities

- Follow all rules, policies and procedures of Dayton City School along with state and federal regulations pertaining to school issues and IDEA.
- Work with individual students or small groups of students to provide educational interventions and progress monitoring.
- Maintain records of interventions and progress monitoring to insure process fidelity.
- Maintain high level of ethical behavior and confidentiality of information.
- Attend team/parent meetings as required; provide input to teams regarding student academic strengths and weaknesses.
- Provide high quality general education instruction to students who are at-risk in reading, writing and/or mathematics.
- Use identified scientific, research-based interventions focused specifically on individual student difficulties.
- Implement increasingly intense student interventions and monitor student progress according to prescribed procedures.
- Maintain data-based documentation of continuous monitoring of student performance and progress during interventions.
- Provide the high quality instruction time needed to move students to grade level proficiency.
- Participate in universal screening activities and assist with the analysis of the data to identify students in need of response to intervention services.
- Provide data to the school teams and participate in decisions about student progress.
- Utilize tracking system to maintain lists of students participating in interventions.
- Perform related duties and responsibilities as requested by the Director and/or principal.
